CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

To qualify for the **LEAGUE 1** or **LEAGUE 2 CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHIES**, or Runner up positions, each author needs to *enter a minimum of 5 of the 6 club championship competitions*.

Their winning scores will be the sum total of their 5 "best scores" from these 5 or 6 entries ie. Only their highest score from each competition counts, and it is the sum-total of their best 5 scores which will become their final score.

CLUB BEGINNER'S CHAMPION

There is also a club Beginners Champion, the same rule of having to enter 5 of the 6 available competitions also applies.

Beginners images are displayed on a club championship competition night as part of league 2 – but judges are aware of which entries belong to a beginner and will judge them accordingly.

There is no Runner Up to the Club Beginners Champion.

SPF & PAGB "INTER - CLUB" COMPETITIONS

SPF Projected Digital Image Championship

It is at this competition, for all member clubs of the SPF, that Carluke Camera Club will be competing to be one of the Scottish clubs to go forward to the annual PAGB Inter Club PDI Championship at Warwick in 2014.

Will Carluke CC be one of the SPF clubs to go to Warwick next year?

At Warwick in July 2013 Dumfries Camera Club was one of the 8 finalists and has therefore pre-qualified to compete in the PAGB Inter Club PDI Championship next year. At this year's SPF PDI Championship, which will be taking place soon - in November 2013, Carluke CC will be competing against other SPF clubs to be one of the 2 clubs which will be joining Dumfries CC at Warwick next year.

SPF Print Championship

This print competition is exactly the same as the PDI Championship, with 2 of the top clubs going forward to compete in the PAGB annual Inter Club Print Championship – along with any other Scottish clubs which might have pre-qualified from the previous year.

The next SPF Print Championship competition is in February 2014 – but, the PAGB Inter Club Print Championship will be taking place soon; on the 26th October 2013 at Connah's Quay.

4 Scottish Clubs – each hoping to become the 2013 PAGB Club Print Champion Club

At Connah's Quay in October 2012 Dumfries CC & Carluke CC pre qualified to return
again this year. In February 2013 - Edinburgh
Photographic Society along with Dundee
Photographic Society beat the other clubs in the SPF
Print Championship to earn their place at this year's
PAGB Inter Club Print Championship.

PAGB Inter Federation Competitions

The PAGB also run Print & PDI Inter Federation
Competitions where the best of the images & prints from
members of the SPF clubs will be chosen to represent the
federation itself at these competitions. Sometimes there
selections will include images from CCC

PAGB: Inter Club PDI Championship

At this competition the 8 clubs who were finalists from the previous year are invited back to compete along with the 2 clubs which have qualified from each of the PAGB member federations.

In July of each year this annual competition, where the winner will become the PAGB PDI Champion Club, takes place at Warwick University Arts Centre in Coventry.

An annual PDI competition with an Open, Small Club and a Natural History section. Any club who is affiliated to the PAGB can enter this competition.

In February 2013 Carluke CC finished 6th= with Cambridge in the Open section.

GDPU "INTER - CLUB" COMPETITIONS + GDPU PRINT SALON

GDPU: JOHN DUFFY PORTFOLIO

At the start of each year GDPU member clubs put forward 4 prints which are judged as individual entries. The top 50 prints are then put into a travelling portfolio which is passed round every club on their viewing rota.

Carluke Camera Club will display the 2013/14 portfolio of prints on Friday 28th February 2014.

GDPU: CLUB PRINT EXHIBITION

GDPU clubs enter a panel of 4 prints to be judged against all other club entries. The winning panel, and all other club panels are displayed at the exhibition.

GDPU: BEGINNER'S PRINT EXHIBITION

There is also a beginner's section of the above competition - for individual club member's where the winning print, and the best of the other beginners' prints will also be displayed at the GDPU Print Exhibition.

GDPU: PRINT SALON

This print competition is for individual members of clubs that are affiliated to the GDPU, where the winning entries are now judged and displayed as part of the GDPU Print Exhibition.

Awards given are: BEST PRINT IN COMPETITION; BEST COLOUR PRINT & BEST MONOCHROME PRINT

Plus, JUDGES CHOICES from the 3 judges of the salon and print exhibition.

GDPU:DIGITAL IMAGE LEAGUE

Each year GDPU member clubs compete in leagues of approximately 4 clubs.
Each League winner then meets in a final PDI battle at East Kilbride in April of each year.

In 2013/14 Carluke CC will be competing against, Airdrie & Coatbridge CC, Penilee CC and Hamilton CC.
