Is it expensive to be a member?

The membership fee for the 2025-26 season is £70. There is no nightly fee payable.

Do I need expensive equipment?

No, you don't need any special type of camera to be a member, in fact you don't need a camera at all unless you want to enter competitions. To enter our competitions all you need is a camera phone or basic camera and access to a computer.

Interested in Club Competitions

The Club runs a Championship competition consisting of 6 competitions annually. We also have Annual Print and Annual Digital competitions with separate subject categories. Full Rules are supplied separately.

Membership must be paid to be eligible to enter. Help is available on how to enter for anyone who requires assistance. Anyone joining us from another Scottish Club is asked not to use any work used externally with that previous Scottish Club.
